

The state of HR Jobs in The Netherlands Q3 -2014

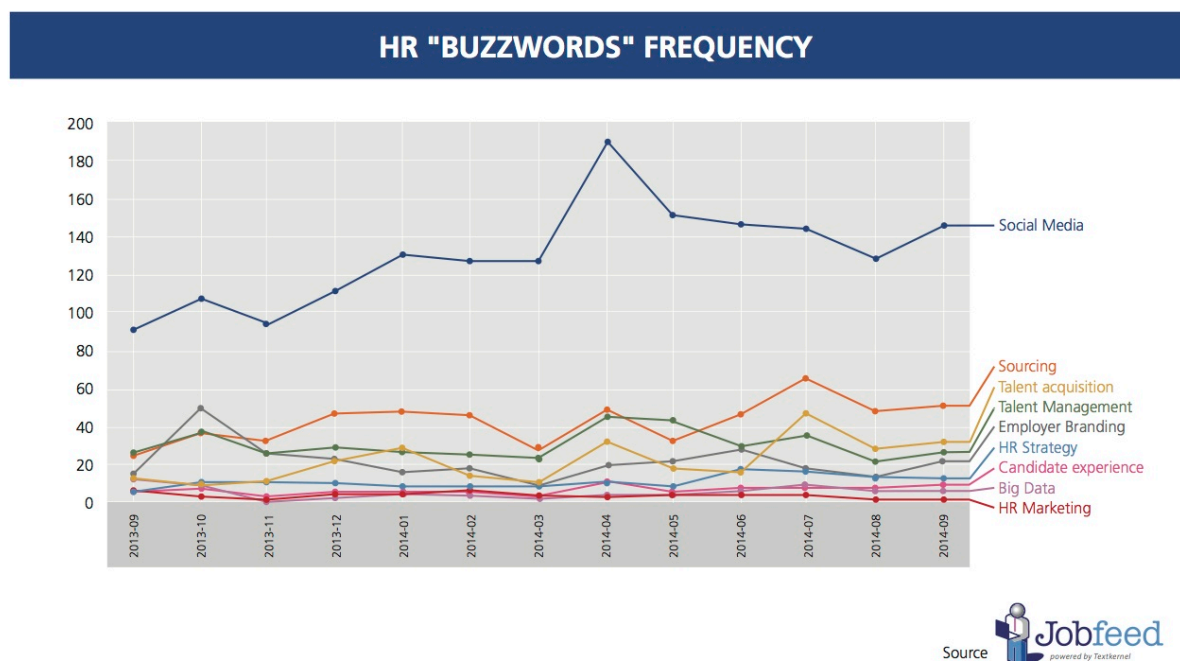
This quarterly study has been prepared using data from Jobfeed, Textkernel's job market analysis tool. By collecting online jobs, extracting data and indexing it in a searchable database, Jobfeed makes it possible to single out a specific sector or profession. This analysis focuses especially on jobs in the human resources sector published online between 1 July and 30 September 2014. The following figures are presented in this study:

HR Buzzwords

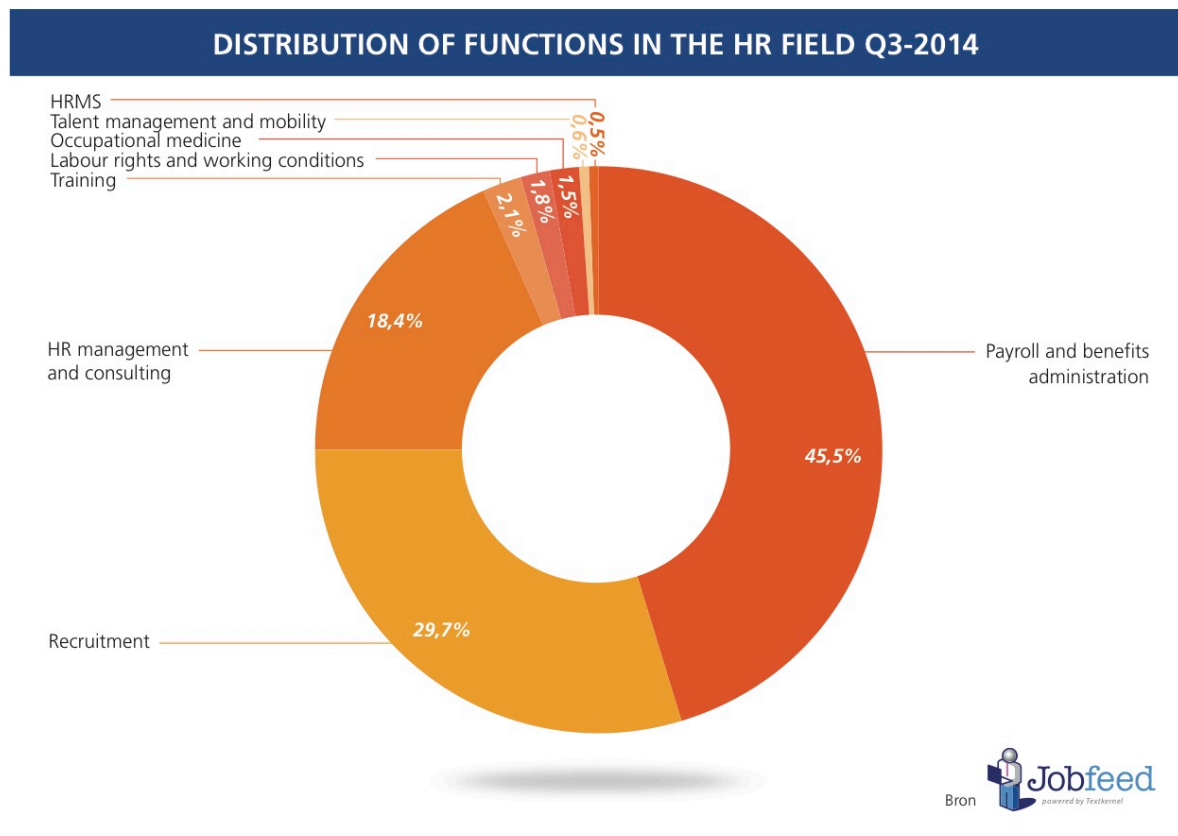

Distribution of HR jobs per function

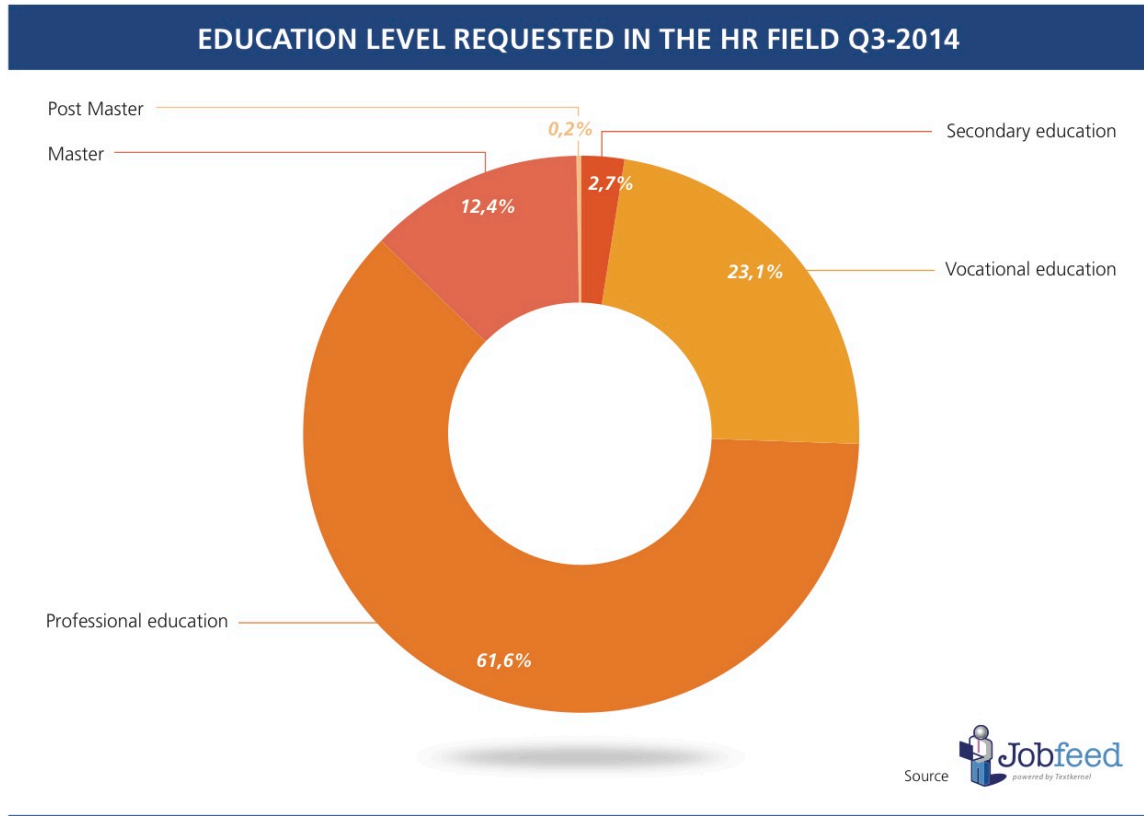
In order to show the distribution of HR jobs in Q3 2014, we have grouped the different HR professions within 8 major functions. Administrative functions such as payroll and benefit administration represented the vast majority of HR jobs in the past quarter.

Education level requested for HR jobs

In order to approach the question of education level, we have grouped education level into five education groups: vocational education, professional education, bachelor, master and post-master. Only a quarter of all jobs is targeted at lower education level.

Method and source

Numbers come from Jobfeed, the job market analysis tool of Textkernel that collects, analyses and indexes all jobs published online The Netherlands. This study is based on 21 138 HR jobs (5 131 unique jobs) published online and collected in the third quarter of 2014.

About Textkernel

In 2003, Textkernel started aggregating job vacancy information for matching and analytical purposes under the label 'Jobfeed' in the Netherlands. Now, Textkernel is the market leader in this domain and has been expanding Jobfeed to Germany and France. Jobfeed searches the Internet daily for new jobs via an automated process and determines with machine learning technology whether a page is a job vacancy or not. Found jobs are automatically cleaned, extracted, categorised, enriched, deduplicated and recorded in the Jobfeed database. Due to its strong technological base and domain knowledge, Textkernel created a unique source for making job market data available for insight into the demand side of the labour market.
