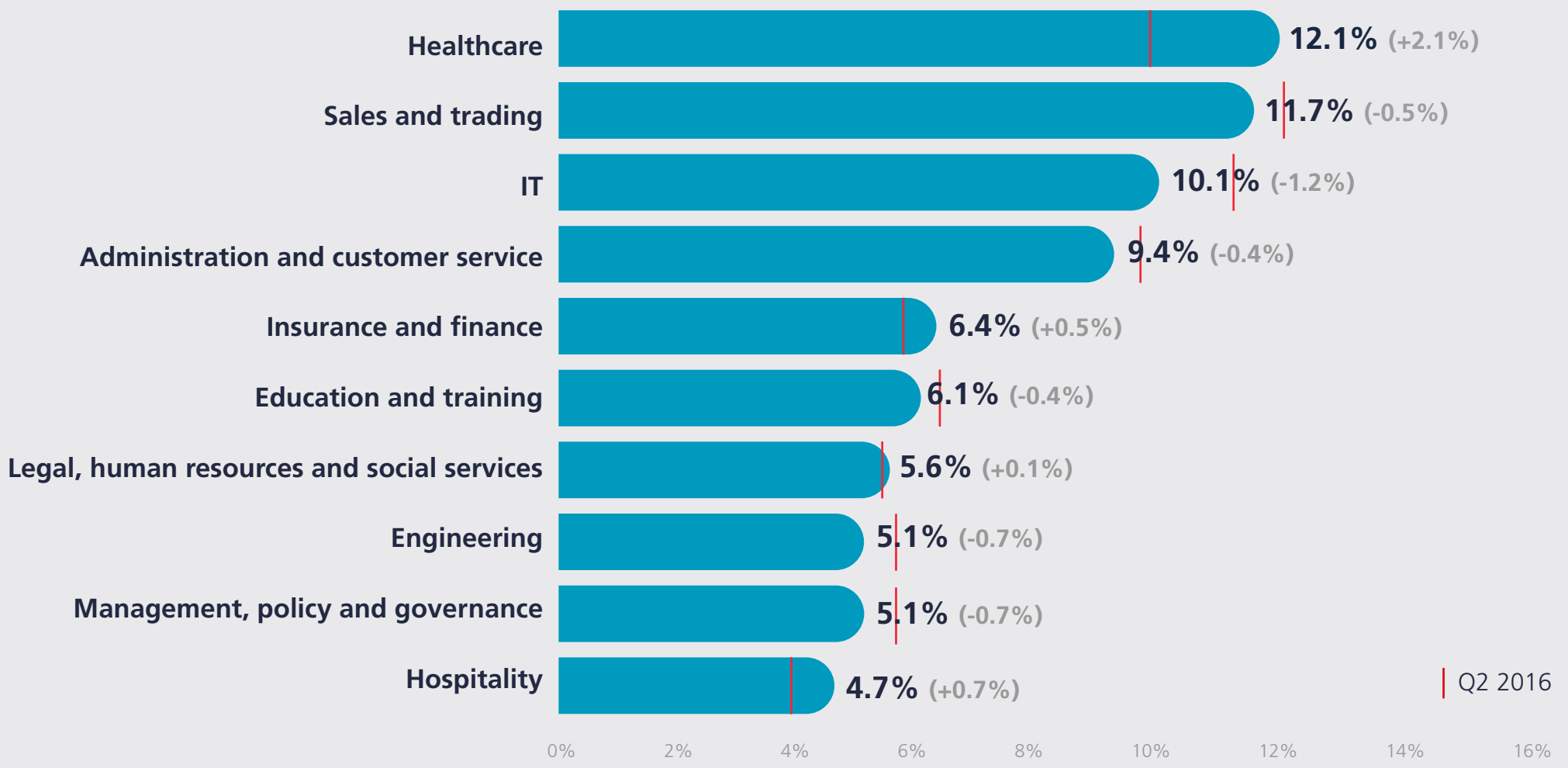

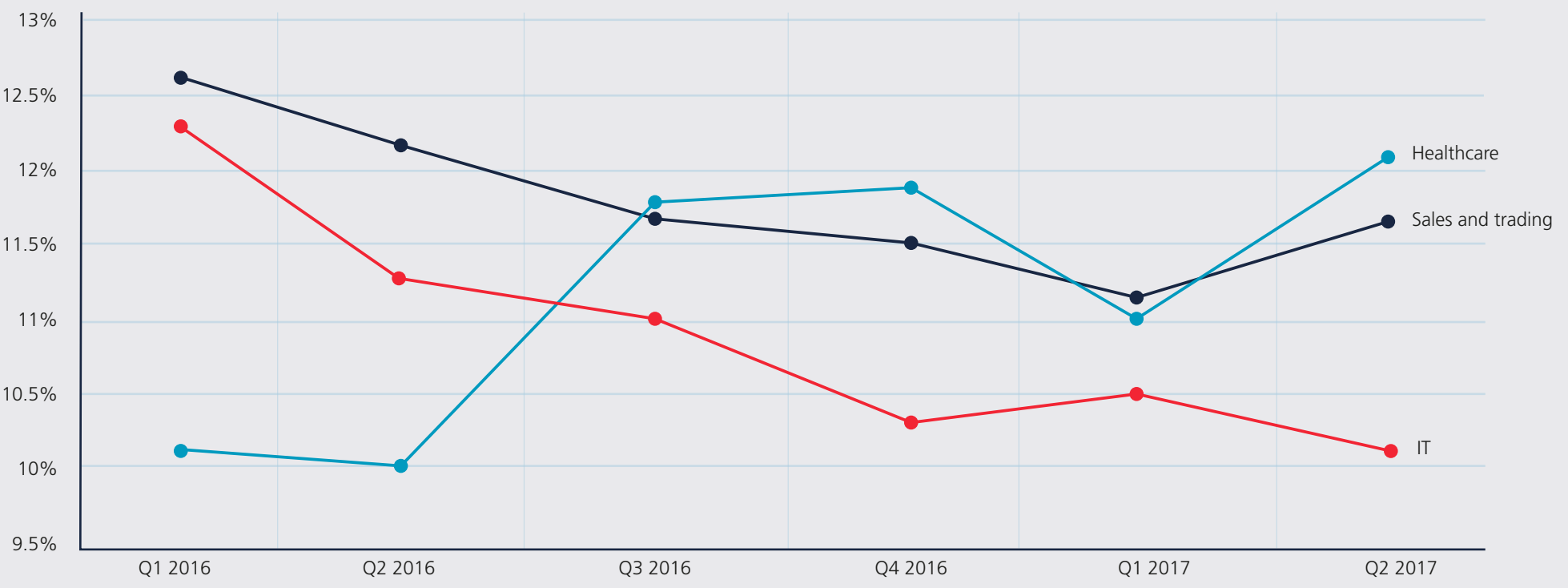

4 Customer service agent

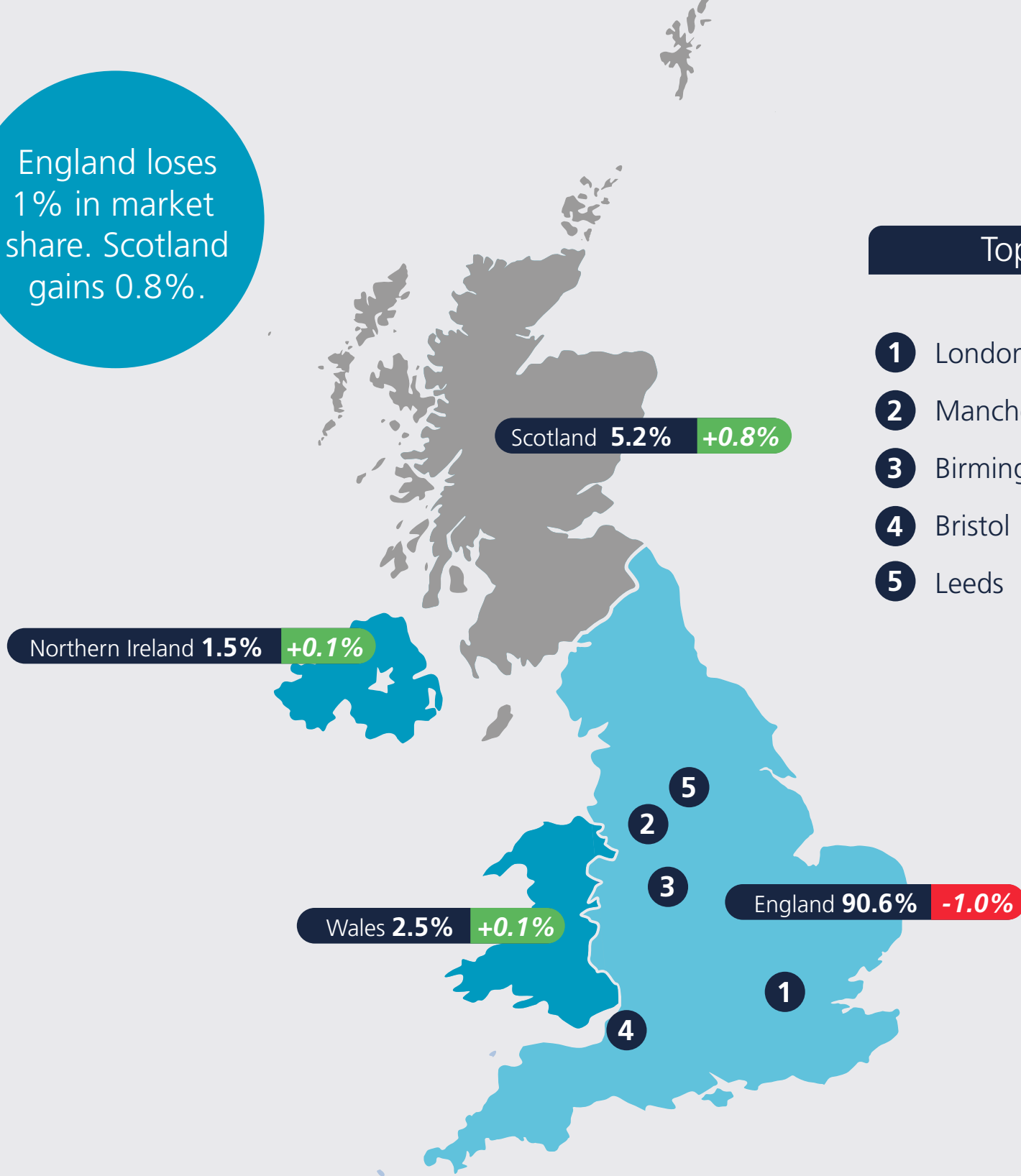
