

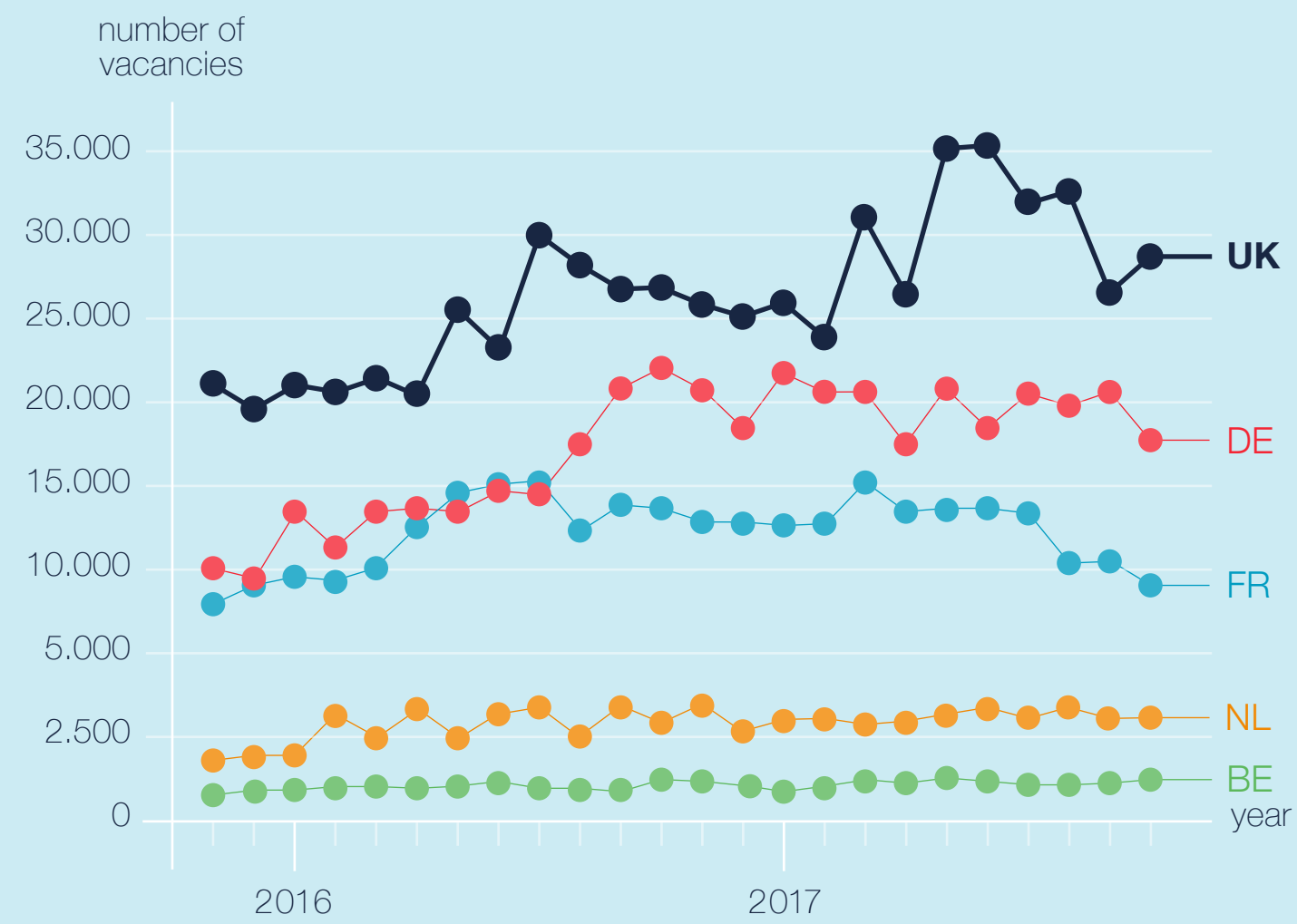

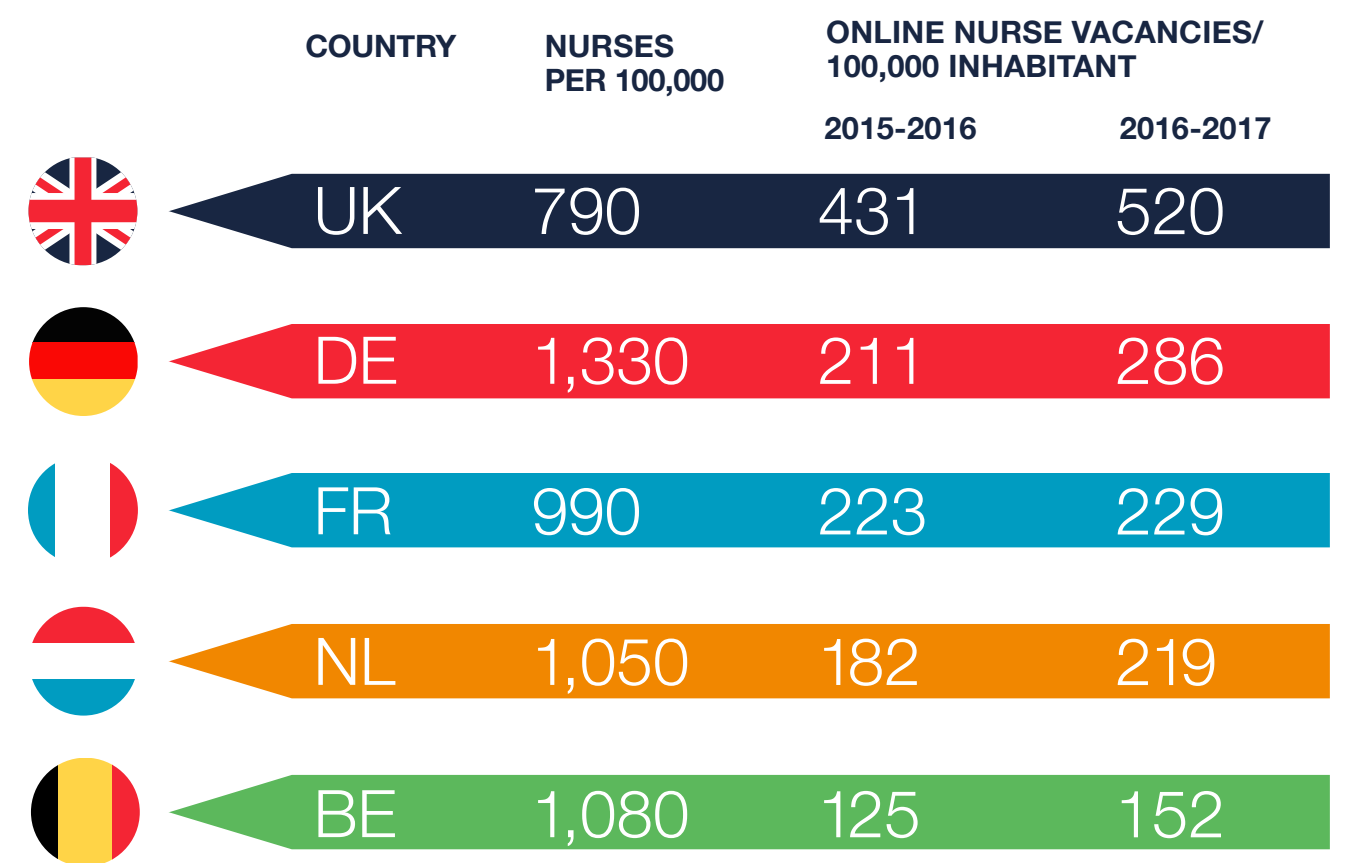

per month



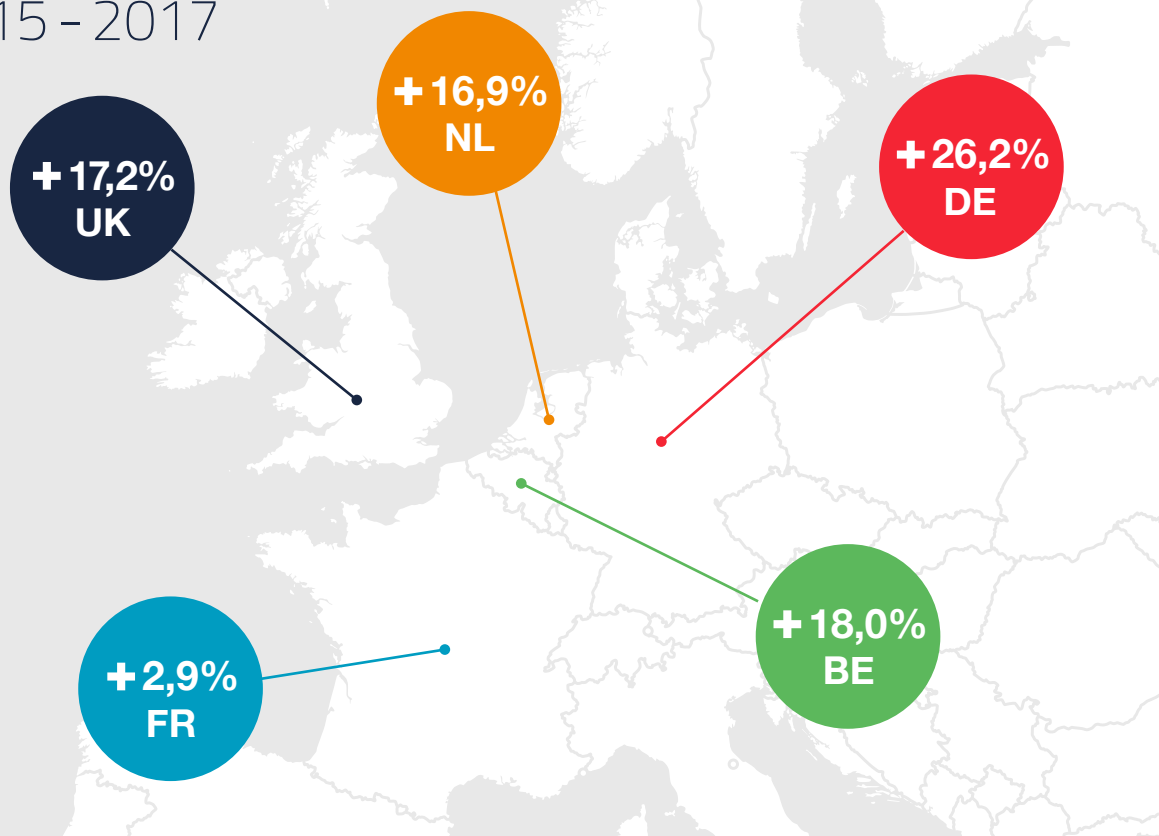
## Nurse vacancies per 100,000 inhabitants



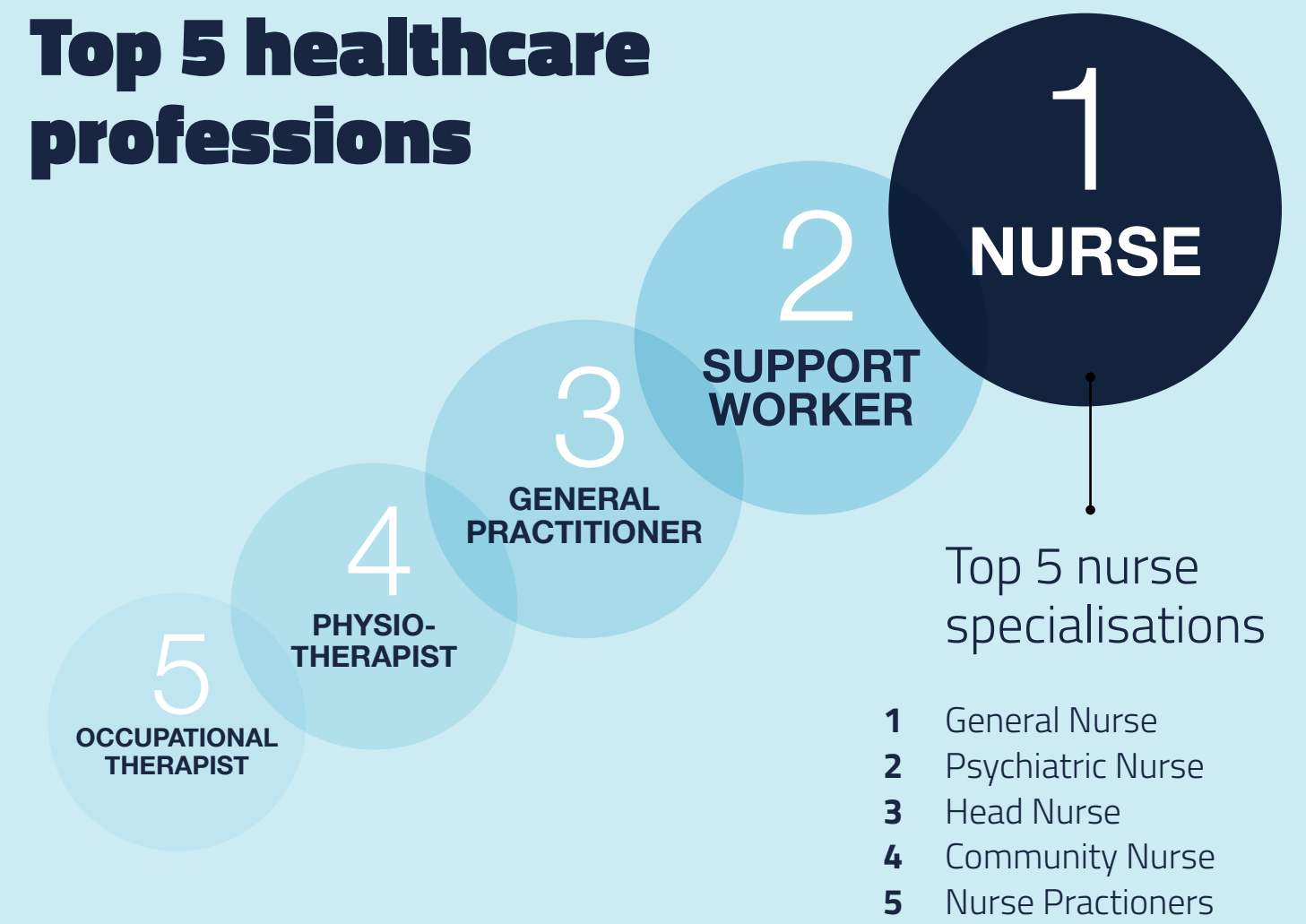
The UK has both the lowest number of nurses per inhabitant and the most vacancies posted online.

between 2015 - 2017

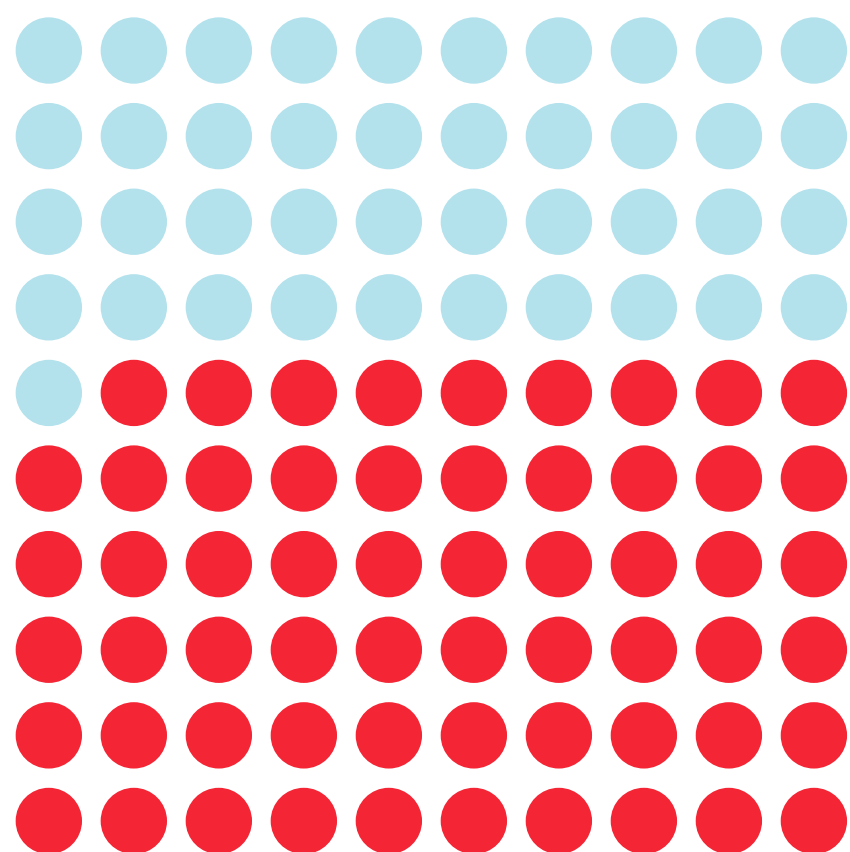


## Top 5 healthcare professions



## Job postings: Agency vs direct employer

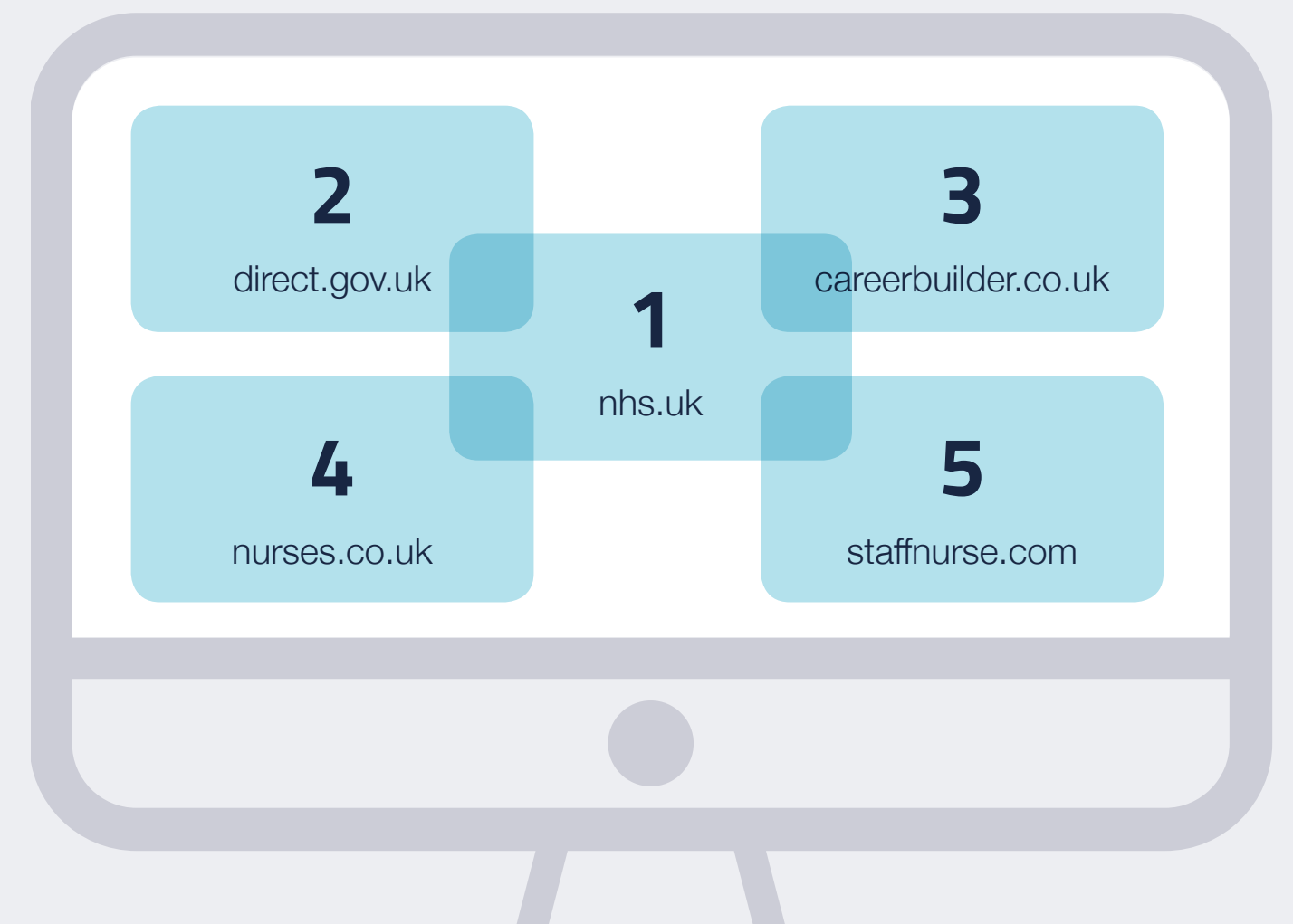
Direct employer 40,88%
